WAITRO - ASIA & THE PACIFIC IN CONTRIBUTION TO SDG 2 WORKING GROUP

National Research and Innovation Agency (BRIN) - Indonesia has led a new initiative establishing a WAITRO SDG 2: Zero Hunger Working Group since 2022 at WAITRO Summit in Cape Town. It was formed to provide a platform for collaboration and to amplify WAITRO's contribution towards the specific SDG.

On 14 December 2023, the WAITRO SDG2 Working Group Webinar "Harvesting Global Solutions: Uniting for Zero Hunger Research Collaboration and Funding Opportunities" was held by BRIN to follow up and further develop the WAITRO SDG2 Working Group. There was sharing of knowledge, and lessons learned experience, among the experts and stakeholders from different regions. In addition, BRIN has introduced funding schemes of research funding and research mobility programs to allow researchers and member organizations to conduct research related to SDG2 in Indonesia.
