This initiative was given within the framework of a strategic alliance between WAITRO members, the Center of Science and Technology of Antioquia (CTA) of Colombia, the LEITAT Technological Center of Spain and the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and SME (MICM) of the Dominican Republic. As a result of belonging and knowing each other, when the call for proposals was opened, we were able to meet the requirements and the formulation in a very short time because we knew "which way to go". International projects accompany relationships and linkages that have already been developed and therefore, when the resources appear, it is easy to coordinate and agree on how and when.

Working for and together with SMEs is the great challenge we have as a region and globally, but if we make alliances and work as a network, the opportunities are endless, the commitment depends on each one of us and WAITRO offers us a great possibility to do so.



Important step forward for the development of MSMEs in Latin America and the Caribbean!

We are pleased to inform you that the Triangular Cooperation Initiative "Sustainable Transformation for the Competitiveness of MSMEs" has been approved within the framework of Ventana ADELANTE of the European Union - Latin America and the Caribbean Triangular Cooperation ADELANTE 2021-2024.

This valuable Initiative, in charge of the Triangular Cooperation Alliance together with the European Union, aims to share the knowledge of the Alliance institutions to develop tools for digital transformation and promotion of the circular economy, adapted to the MSMEs needs, seeking greater competitiveness and sustainability in the region.

The implementation period of this initiative will begin on August 14, 2023 and will culminate on May 9, 2024. The activities will be carried out in both virtual and in person formats, allowing a wide participation. The total budget amounts to 199,706 euros, of which 137,065 euros will be financed by the Ventana ADELANTE and 62,641 euros will be co-financed by the Triangular Cooperation Alliance.

This achievement represents a unique opportunity for the growth and sustainable transformation of MSMEs in the region. Together we will keep working for economic development and environmental preservation!
